What is ACT?

ACT is youth Animators & Chaplains Training programme launched in 2017 by CCBI Youth Commission. It is a crash course in youth ministry.

It aims to:

- Groom young animators and newly appointed chaplains & youth directors.
- Incubate responsible leaders.
- Prepare master trainers in youth ministry.
- Enhance and update youth animation skills
- Hone capacity to face youth ministry related challenges.

COURSE CURRICULUM:

Module 1: Principles & Dynamics of Youth ministry

Models of youth ministry, skills in conducting youth meetings, methods of conducting youth programmes, event management with youth

Module 2 Youth Psychology

Youth psychology, Understanding young people; Youth: their inner world, needs and problems, Counseling skills; Handling youth issues, Case studies.

Module 3: Youth & Media

Media management; basics of Journalism; Handling media related challenges; media education; scope and potential of social media in youth ministry, Media relations and youth ministry, report writing skills; documentation

Module 4: Youth & Spirituality

Youth catechesis; Youcat; DoCAT; Methodology for conducting creative prayer sessions, prayer meetings, Bible study groups, youth CAFE, youth retreats

Module 5: Working with Youth at Risk

Pastoral care of young at risk; specific problems: drugs, addictive behaviours, abuses, deviant behavior, child labour, Human trafficking, Human Rights & Youth.

Module 6: Youth and Life Skills

Self-awareness, Empathy, Critical thinking, Creative thinking, Decision making, Problem Solving, Effective communication, Interpersonal relationship, Coping with stress, Coping with emotion.

Module 7: Youth and Vocational Guidance

Tips on Vocation Promotion & Discernment, Career guidance; Knowledge on job opportunities; Job placement,

Module 8: Youth Ministry and Social Consciousness

Care for the earth; G-India, Feed a friend, Laudato Si, challenging youth for social activism, Civic responsibility, instilling political consciousness, networking with other youth movements

During this training participants will be sent to local parishes/schools for exposure programme. Participants will be trained to write projects, reports, office management, media management and other skills.

There will be practical sessions on conducting cell meetings, holding press conference, creating short videos, reels and youth group meetings.

Pls Note: Participants are expected to attend all the sessions and remain till the end of the course. We dont encourage participants joining late and going early.
